Staying on Track in 2016

In Stephen Covey's popular book "7 Habits of Highly Effective Families," he points out some very interesting observations that easily fit the church, our spiritual family. Covey helps us understand that no family is ever on track 100% of the time. Even the very best of families will have their moments when they stray from the healthy ideal into dangerous or harmful territory. The key is not to expect or demand perfection, but to be careful that enough adjustments are made along the way so that you are always "en route." No church is perfect. When imperfect individuals gather in a group setting, there will be differences of opinion, conflicts, misunderstandings, and hurt feelings. The key is to be careful and sensitive to make the necessary adjustments so family life and the spirit of unity in Christ is not paralyzed or destroyed. Accept the fact that perfection comes later when we no longer look through a glass darkly from a world swimming in sin, self-service, and small mindedness. No one is exempt from falling in the blink of an eye. We are all sinners and fall short of the glory of God, and praise His name, in spite of our sin God has shown His love for us by allowing Christ to die for us!

It takes much self control and discipline to be able to esteem others as better than ourselves and to forgive all manner of evil done against us. About the time you feel you've mastered a particular difficulty, pride or lust will be waiting to show you again just how imperfect you really are.

Recognizing our imperfection doesn't mean we are to hopelessly live there. We look to the author and finisher of our faith to supply what we need to journey through the difficulties and continue to build up the body of Christ. Our ultimate purpose and destination are more important than this day's burden or bump in the road. This bump might be the unruly tongue of an immature believer or the thoughtless un-Christlike action taken by one or more family members. Covey states that effectiveness in a family is a beautiful family culture that has moved from "me" to "we." It is another demonstration of the selflessness and sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Be ever so careful to discover what steps may be taken to support, love, and minister to one another.

Determine to pray for those in your church family, but not "God, change them or make them thus and so." Instead pray for the one you know best, that YOU will be teachable in God's hands to be a blessing, encouragement, and help to those around you. With more of us praying in this fashion we are certain to more often be on track than off.
