### The Top 10 Issues Facing Today's Family

A few years back Lifeway conducted a survey to determine the top ten issues facing today's families. The results have been used to develop resources specifically targeting the most pressing needs. Some of the resources we have seen include devotionals, dramas, sermon outlines, scripture passages, Web sites, sermon illustrations, PowerPoint presentations, video clips, book excerpts, and music.

For those of us in the local church, this information can be very helpful as we continue to develop and fine tune our own ministries making them relevant to families in our communities. When we ask the question, "How can we reach the lost?", each congregation will have to determine their own strategy, and zero in on those issues they feel more equipped to tackle. Without a doubt, some very effective and creative opportunities can be designed that will help us not only strengthen families but help us focus our energies and efforts on pointing people to Christ and making proper disciples.

As you consider each of the following threats facing your family and church, begin to formulate a strategy that will lessen the grip of these very real challenges that undermine biblical values and harm personal godliness. Don't be afraid to write out your thoughts and share them with others.

- 10. Materialism: "The placing in high regard of ownership and consumption as a family priority."
- **9. Balance of Work and Family:** "The rising pressure to invest more of one's energy in work at the expense of family."
- **8. Negative Media Influences:** "The growing influx of destructive images and messages into the home."
- **7. Lack of Communication:** "The increasing abbreviation or near elimination of meaningful family member interaction."
- 6. Financial Pressures: "The chronic misuse of debt and/or mismanagement of financial resources."
- **5. Lack of Discipline:** "The death of respectful behavior as a norm in our schools, churches, and families."
- 4. Lack of a Father Figure: "The absence of a father in the home or lack of strong participation in the family."
- **3. Busyness:** "The participation in numerous activities crowding out quality family fellowship."
- 2. Divorce: "The ongoing wave of broken marriages and families both within the church and without."
- 1. Anti-Christian Culture: "The stripping away of Christian heritage and traditional values."
