Your Pastor Search Committee (PSC) has been very busy the last couple months. One of our first tasks was to gather information and develop profiles.

We have developed a prospective pastor profile based on the results of the congregational survey conducted in January and the meeting with the membership on Sunday evening, February 8, 2015.

The new pastor profile in brief:


- 35 to 45 years old
- Married
- Attended seminary
- 1-5 years prior experience as a pastor
- Most important strength is preaching that is personal, relational, engaging, and based on the Scriptures.
- Priorities leadership vision, plan for the future and visiting members.
- Supportive of more contemporary musical elements.

Currently, we are developing profiles of our church and community to help make a good match between the new pastor and us.

The resume process has already started too. Last week each member of the committee received eleven resumes for review and consideration.

It was also decided at the February 8 membership meeting that the interim pastor would be full time, i.e., perform all duties during the transition period. The Board of Deacons will be in charge of getting our interim pastor.

The PSC very much appreciates your continued support and especially your prayers. We will continue to provide updates so you will know what is going on.

Create a beautiful decoration for your window this Easter. It will remind you that Jesus rose from the dead to save you from your sins.

What you need:

- 81/2" x 11" sheet of paper
- Pencil
- Clear transparency sheet (or clear report cover)
- Permanent marker
- Scissors
- Colored tissue paper
- Paintbrush
- Glue
- Scotch tape

What you do:

- 1. Draw a large cross that takes up most of the paper.
- 2. Put the transparency over the paper and trace the cross onto it with a permanent marker.
- 3. Cut the colored tissue paper into 1" x 1" squares.
- 4. Using a paintbrush, spread glue onto the tissue paper squares and then place them on the cross. (Add a few drops of water to the white glue to make it more spreadable.)
- 5. After the glue is dry, cut out the cross. Then tape it in a window and enjoy the beautiful colors.

The Real Meaning of the Cross

"At the cross we understand what God means when He talks of loving us, begin to take it in that there is nothing that He will not do, no sacrifice He will not make, no suffering that He will shirk, if only He can help us. 'He loved me,' said Paul, standing upon Calvary and gazing in a stunned way at the cross, 'I who was a persecutor, and blasphemer, and injurious , and yet He loved me and He gave Himself for me.' And with that Paul's heart broke, and the old life was gone."
